

Vedic Realizations


- God manifests himself in cosmos in infinite ways

- 3. Each individual soul can approach Supreme Divine through a universal consciousness


- 1. Human Aspiration Divine life is inevitable






Samam Brahman

Activity is based on timeless, spaceless immutable stability – *sthanu*




Two facts of existence: Being and Becoming






Two facts of existence: Becoming and Being

I have become a foam-white sea of bliss,


I am a curling wave of God's delight,
