
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
Mind cuts up reality into parts

Elizabeth	Mind	Self-absorption [Exclusive concentration]
Audience	Divine Being as Enjoyer	Self-enjoyment

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Elizabeth's Reversal

Elizabeth's reversals	Life's Response
Humility – She feels ashamed & humiliated by disgrace	News of Lydia's marriage plans
Truthfulness She gives up false attraction to Wickham	Lydia reveals that Darcy attended the marriage
Knowledge – meeting Wickham she sees he is shameless and shallow	Mrs. Gardiner reveals Darcy found Wickham & paid for it
Aspiration hope awakens where before there was none	Bingley & Darcy return to Netherfield
Goodwill – she prays for Jane's marriage and joys in her happiness	Bingley proposes to Jane
Gratitude – conscious of Darcy's goodness & generosity	Lady Catherine battles Elizabeth at Longbourn
Will – Her courage & self-respect assert against Lady Catherine	Darcy returns to Longbourn & proposes
