

Divine Soul lives self-contained in the play of Sachchidananda

- Aware of itself as pure and infinite self-existence
- Aware of itself as pure, unlimited consciousness in its energy
- Aware of itself as inalienable delight in its eternal self-experience

DIVINE SOUL LIVES CONSTANTLY IN THE PRESENCE OF THE ABSOLUTE

Divine Soul lives simultaneously in the One and the Many

- One and Many are the two terms of Sachchidananda
- One and Many are inseparable poles of the selfunfolding Absolute

Divine Soul is aware of all its self-expressions as forms of Sachchidananda

- All that forms in Sachchidananda are manifested potentialities of the One
- All variations of Being, Consciousness, Will and Delight are self-expressions of the unity and infinite oneness
- Divine Soul is conscious of Sachchidananda in its Being and also in its Becoming

Divine Soul is aware of the three grades of Supermind as a triune self-manifestation of Sachchidananda

Comprehending Supermind

- Equal self-extension of Sachchidananda
- All things are the Self
- Self becomes all existences
- This is the basis of our oneness



Apprehending Supermind

- Unequal instead of equable concentration
- Knowledge centralizes itself and stand back from its works to observe them.
- All existences are soul-forms of the One
- Self contains all existences
- This is the basis of oneness in difference



Spiritual Individual

- Self takes on a million personalities and develops and experiences them but never forgets he is the Divine.
- Self inhabits all existences as Individual Divine
- This is the basis of our individuality



Three aspects of One Existence

- Essentiality One Self becomes all
- Commonalty One Self contains all
- Individuality One Self inhabits all, but expresses uniquely in each

Triune Realization

- The divine soul is simultaneously conscious of all three
- Transcendent, universal and individual are various forms of expression of an essential unity manifesting multiplicity but remaining always essentially One
- This comprehensive self-knowledge governs all relations of the divine soul with God, the supreme Self and other selves

Divine Soul's relations of enjoyment

- It feels Delight in all its own experience of itself
- It feels Delight in experiencing relation with all others
- It feels Delight of experiencing other selves as if they were itself
